National Registry on Renal Replacement Therapy (Haemodialysis, Peritoneal Dialysis, Renal Transplantation) that collects and analyzes individual patient data from almost all Greek Nephrology Centers and provides the resulting information to ERA-EDTA Registry.

Other Registries. Registry of IgAN (D. Goumenos et al, Clin Kidney J), Registry of idiopathic membranous nephropathy (A. Papagianni, submitted), Registries of FSGS, peritoneal dialysis, central venous haemodialysis catheters and chronic kidney disease in progress.

Fellowship programs or educational opportunities for young doctors (if any)

HSN institutes every year, clinical or research, short term (6 months for the amount of 5.000 euro) or long-term (1 year for the amount of 10.000 euro) fellowship grants to its members through a call for competition. In addition, HSN institutes every year, two grants (each for the amount of 3000 euro) in young nephrologists to support the conduction of their PhD thesis. Finally, HSN in collaboration with ERA-EDTA and Stavros Niarchos Foundation institutes every

year clinical or research short or long-term grants for Young Greek Nephrologists with the same scopes.

Short description of the Society (preferably no more than 2000 characters)

Hellenic Society of Nephrology, abbreviated HSN, was founded in 1970 and it is no-profit medical-scientific association, with its headquarters in Athens. Its principal aim is to promote all fields of Nephrology including basic science, clinical nephrology, haemodialysis-peritoneal dialysis and renal transplantation. In this context, HSN encourages and support continuous education, training and updating to his members by organizing every year several educational meetings and seminars and every year, the "Panhellenic Congress of Nephrology".

Since 1989, HSN publishes quarterly its official journal "ΕΛΛΗΝΙΚΗ ΝΕΦΡΟΛΟΓΙΑ-HELLENIC NEPHROLOGY", a peer review open access medical journal [ISSN 1105-140X (print), ISSN 1792-8907 (online)]. All society members receive a free subscription to the printed issues of the journal. Official language of the journal is Greek, but it accepts also papers written in English and all papers provide the title, authors and institutions, abstract and key words in English. Its aim is to provide current and reliable scientific information to Nephrologists and other physicians interested in renal diseases. For this purpose, the journal covers all aspects of Nephrology. Subjects appropriate for "Hellenic Nephrology" include, but are not restricted to: physiology of the kidney, immunology and pathology, pathophysiology and progression of renal disease, mineral metabolism and bone disease, clinical nephrology, epidemiology and outcomes, dialysis and transplantation. Papers accepted for publication include brief reviews, in-depth reviews, original papers and case reports.
