Short description of the Society (preferably no more than 2000 characters)

The Norwegian Society of Nephrology was established in 1974 and is currently a division of the Norwegian Medical Association. The primary aim of the society is to connect Norwegian doctors and researchers with interest in nephrology and thereby to promote continuous development of renal medicine in Norway. Moreover, we aim to collaborate closely with societies of nephrology in other countries. We arrange 2-3 national scientific meetings every year. The focus of the meetings are in part state-of-the-art presentations from different aspects within nephrology, and in part discussion about ongoing research and other matters of common interest for nephrologists. Nordic conferences are arranged biennially together with the Swedish, Danish, Finnish, Icelandic and societies of nephrology. The Norwegian Society of Nephrology is involved in matters such as specialist training in nephrology and the Norwegian Renal Registry. The board of our organisation consists of a leader, a secretary and two board members elected for two years. Our Journal is called "Nefrologisk Forum" and is published online in Norwegian twice a year.
