**Short description of the Society (preferably no more than 2000 characters)**

Created in 1964, the S.E.N. has now 2000 members, increasing year by year.

The main objectives of our society are: 1) the integrated management of CKD, with active programs for HD, On-line HDF, PD and Renal Transplantation. 2) Continuous Medical Education programs for our fellows and affiliated members and, especially, for young nephrologists. It also includes many different meetings and on-line education topics and boards. 3) The maintenance of an active research-grant program, with a total amount of over 280.000 €/year and also the patronage of our SENEFRO foundation of independent clinical trial for researchers who have not the industry support. 4) The maintenance of our first publication, NEFROLOGIA, in Spanish but also in English in the web version. The impact factor has increased up to 1.274 in 2012 and is distributed in Latin and Ibero-America. Our web page has now an increasing number of visits.

The society has 24 working groups, many of them with important activities. The GEENDIAB, - Grupo de Estudio de la Nefropatía Diabética-, organized last 2013 the 25th Meeting of the European Diabetic Nephropathy Group and a CME Course in collaboration with ERA-EDTA.

We are members of the board of the EURECAm and maintain close relations with some other European and Ibero-Latin America national societies and also with the ISN or the IS of Transplantation..

We are in close relation with the Spanish Transplant Organization of the Ministry of Health (ONT), registering the annual data for the management of CKD-5 D or T. In the last years the incidence of CKD-5 has decreased from 132 patients/pmp in 2003 to 120/pmp in 2012. The prevalence of CKD-5 is situated in 1009/pmp, but more than 51% of the patients have a functioning graf.

We also celebrate an annual Congress with 1100 delegates.
