

The Spanish Dialysis and Transplant Society (SEDYT) is a Nephrology Association founded in 1978 by a group of Nephrologists with the aim of extending their medical activities in dialysis and transplants. Its first President, who launched the association, was Dr. Emilio Rotellar. He accomplished the first dialysis never fulfilled before in Spain, which took place in Barcelona in 1958.

The SEDYT organizes a yearly congress. This year, the 38th, will take place in Burgos from 5th to 7th of May, 2016. The society publishes every three months the magazine Diálisis y Trasplante since 1979 as a tool to spread scientific works, knowledge and the experts opinions.

The SEDYT has its own Foundation" Fundación Española de Diàlisis "which organizes one annual training course on Vascular Access for Dialysis. Moreover, in 2010, SEDYT published a book called "Manual de Accesos Vasculares para Hemodiálisis "by Ma Teresa Gonzalez and R. MartinezCercós. Fundación Española de Diálisis sponsored this book.

Finally, we would like to mention that SEDYT supports several clinical assays, congresses and symposiums in Spain, Latin America and other countries around the world.
